## THE 2<sup>ND</sup> DRR CLASS IMPLEMENTATION

After 1st DRR class, the 2nd DRR class has been carried out at 7 DRR core schools throughout April. 5 DRR models of 5 Disasters and supplementary teaching materials were provided by SEEDS Asia. In addition, models, teaching aids, games made by the teachers in teaching aids competition have been used in the 2nd DRR class to make it more effective than the 1st one. The models and teaching aid



help students understand well and clarify the mechanism, phenomenon as well as impacts of each disaster; thus, student will know how to prepare for, respond to, and recover from disasters.

All DRR programs are conducted in line with KIDA model (Knowledge-Interest-Desire-

Action) in 7 DRR core schools. All lessons are conducted in order to get students interested in learning, and become very active in classes. Knowledge and teaching skills of the teachers in this DRR class were improved a lot; the teachers seemed to be very familiar with

DRR knowledge, well-prepared, and creative in using the models as well as the teaching aids. Before and after a lesson of each disaster, students take tests of DRR knowledge. After learning, they have to take final tests to know how well they understand the knowledge. Most of the students got high scores. The 2<sup>nd</sup> DRR class has been developing and effective as expectation.



## TOT FOR SHARING DRR KNOWDGLE TO

## EDUCATION STAFF AND TEACHERS FROM QUANG NAM AND THUA THIEN HUE PROVINCES

ToT for education staff and teachers from Quang Nam was held for 2 days, on 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> of April, 2013. 37 participants from BoET, DoET, elementary and secondary schools from 6 coastal districts and Bac Tra My of Quang Nam province participated in this ToT. They were interested in



learning and motivated to join all activities. DRR models were presented and shared by SEEDS Asia. 4 skilled teachers, who showed very good performances in 1<sup>st</sup> DRR classes, were selected from 7 DRR core schools to be trainers in this ToT. With their DRR knowledge from the last ToT,



teaching skills, experiences, and high motivation for DRR programs, they demonstrated wonderful DRR classes and contributed to the success of the ToT. Their effective and good performances were highly appreciated by SEEDS Asia.



On 25th and 26th of April, 2013, ToT for sharing DRR knowledge to education staff and teachers from Thua Thien-Hue Province was conducted successfully. Based on the successful activities and the lessons learnt from the ToT Ouang Nam, Lectures and video show on DRR were enhanced with many visual aids such as pictures and videos. In this ToT, participants spent most of their time for working in groups instead of listening trainers' to the explanation about sample lesson plans for all the 5 disasters. The
