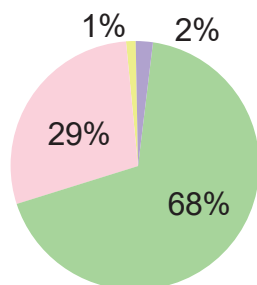

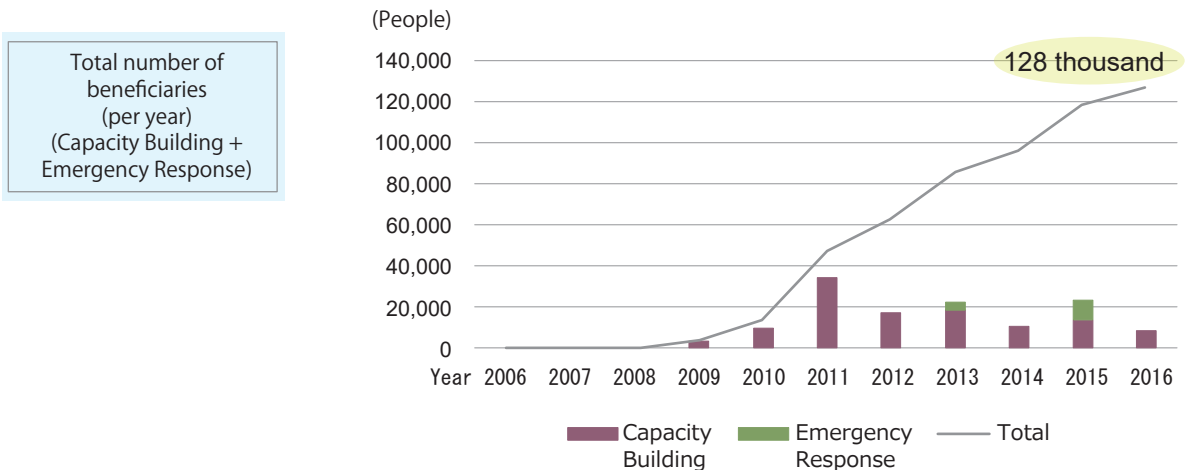
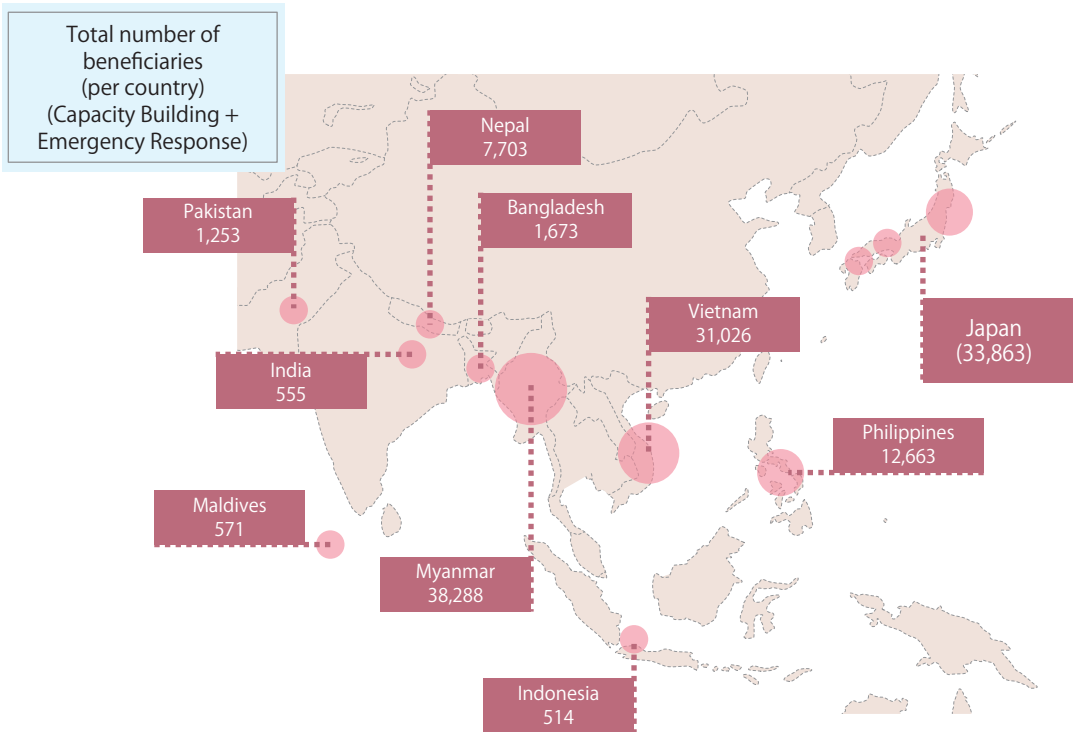

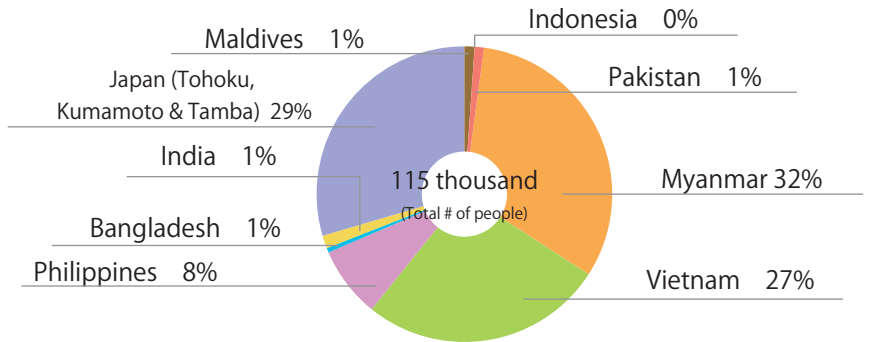


## Number of Beneficiaries (Capacity Building + Emergency Response)

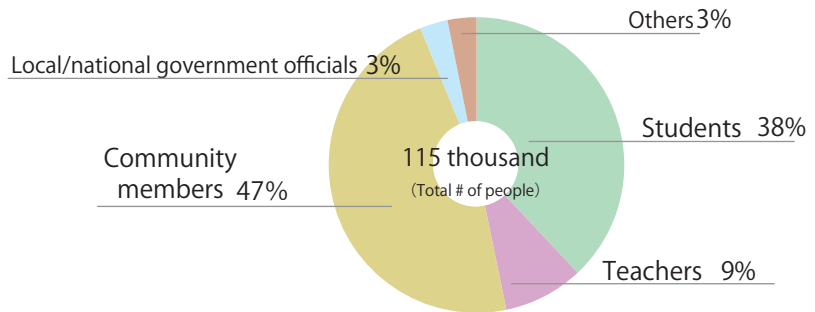


## Beneficiaries of Capacity Building

(Capacity Building)

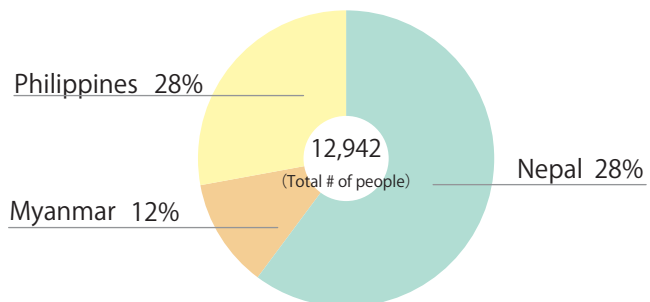


Ratio of beneficiaries
