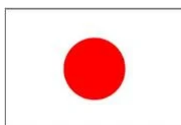

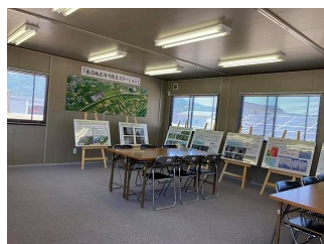

On 1st June, an event to launch the newly established residents' community hub was organized in Naganuma district, Nagano city. Naganuma was seriously impacted by the flood brought about

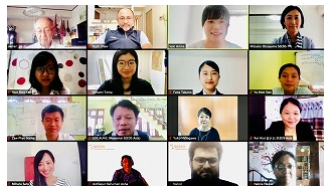

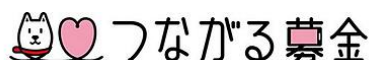
